The joint DBA is a full-fledged school doctoral degree diploma and shall be awarded to students who meet the condition required for the DBA at the Paris School of Business and have their dissertation validated.

Contrary to the Ph.D. the focus is on professional experience. It is an opportunity to broaden personal and professional horizons by encompassing careers that are in the highest echelons of the corporate, business, and academic worlds. The uniqueness of the DBA is the utilization of accumulated life experience as a foundation for research. The DBA focuses on the production of concepts and methods that contribute to advancing the management science corpus.

Programme Structure

Pedagogy

Year 1 is designed around core methodology courses and seminars to help candidates develop their research methodology skills while clarifying their research projects. In Years 2 and 3, the DBA candidates, tutored by doctoral faculty, organise their research topic and engage in the process of writing the doctoral dissertation.

Student Intake

There will be one intake of students per year. Applicants must hold a Masters's degree and have at least 6 years of professional experience. The next intake of students is scheduled for **December 2023**.



The tuition fees for the 3-year DBA are €31,650 per student.
